## **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**CHAIRPERSON** – Good Morning Area, I'm an addict called Donna. Welcome to the Eugene Area Service Committee meeting for September. Our theme this month is the 4<sup>th</sup> Tradition, which states, "Each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or NA as a whole." Over the past month I've been contacted by several concerned members of NA about some of the meetings in this area. One concern was that a particular meeting wasn't taking place when members arrived to support it. Another concern was a meeting not using NA literature. Our guidelines for group participation in area state an NA group shall be defined as stated in the approved service manual of Narcotics Anonymous: "The Guide to Local Services in Narcotics Anonymous," on page 26. That is:

1. All members of a group are drug addicts, and all drug addicts are eligible for membership.
2. As a group, they are self-supporting.
3. As a group, their single goal is to help drug addicts recover through application of the Twelve Steps of Narcotics Anonymous.
4. As a group, they have no affiliation outside Narcotics Anonymous.
5. As a group, they express no opinion on outside issues.
6. As a group, their public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion.

If you attend a meeting and they're using another fellowship's literature, speak with the chairperson or secretary. Find out why they aren't using NA approved literature, remind them that as a group in this area it's a requirement to only use NA approved literature. If you attend a meeting and the meeting doesn't happen or the doors don't open, stay there and be of service in case another addict shows up. You are supporting NA as a whole in this manner. There can always be a number of extenuating circumstances. Our Basic Text says "We are each other's eyes and ears." I feel we can teach by example and be loving and caring at the same time. That being said, let's get on with our business. It's a beautiful day outside.
