SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

ACTIVITIES – Hello I am Vanessa and an addict; Thank you everyone who came out for the Halloween dance and supported area, as we fully self-supported our dance with covering all our cost and allowed us to have some fun and create unity. In addition we had a couple extra hundred dollars. Those numbers have not been finalized yet, because we haven't had our Activities Meeting for the month. Our dance is on New Year's Eve at Agate Hall, starting at 8:00pm. I went to Region last month and brainstormed ideas about their Areas and how things work out there with the money flow and deposits for campouts, retreats, etc. This is important, so I hope all the GSRs are listening to me because this will be up to all of you and your groups, because I will be coming back here and bringing some important motions as well as changes. I have been on the Activities Committee for three years, this is how Activities has been working and how in the past, we hold picnics, dances and we have bowling nights once a month. We would/could do other stuff sometimes when people have ideas, like dinner nights and more if you all would come to Activities Meetings and let us know what you are thinking about doing. Our picnics are something we just pay for and invite everyone and provide food. Costs have gone up every year, (this year too) and when we reserve for three dates at once, the cost of reserving and the cost of food goes up as well. Our dances, now that is another thing with money. The only time I have seen money come in for them is on Halloween and New Year's Eve...and sometimes Valentine's Day; and it is only a few hundred over, which is awesome- just the fact that we fully support our cost and have unity. But the cost to put on dances has gone up over the years. This dance cost \$670.00 and we brought in eight hundred-something- we were left with \$200.00. My point here is that campouts, retreats etc. should put on their own events, and be able to come to Activities and request seed money. \$350.00 up to \$499.00. These event costs have gone up every year, and there is not enough money in Activities' Prudent Reserve. I will be review and bring all proposed ideas to Area. Activities wants to look at a Prudent Reserve for each event and I will have more information on this at the next Area. *Clarification w/ help from Russ: Activities would like to take the women's retreat, men's retreat and camp recovery and change them from Ad hoc to set events that have line items in the budget. This plan is in the discussion phase. Take to groups: discussing structure of funding for these 3 events.
