### GOOD OF THE ORDER

Hello Area, Monday Night Newcomers is inviting other groups in the area to participate in an activity called "Capture the Banner". This activity is borrowed from the Arkansas Region of Narcotics Anonymous (see attached flyers) <EASC Secretary note: did not receive attached flier to put in minutes> The purpose of the game is to encourage an exchange of ideas and experiences between groups and to further foster unity within our area. The Monday Night Newcomers Group has a Narcotics Anonymous related banner, which is hung during our meetings. In order for another group to capture this banner, the group must bring at least five home group members to our meeting. After the meeting, the group can take the banner to their home group and hang the banner there. In order for Monday Night Newcomers Group to recapture our banner, we must bring at least five home group members to your meeting to bring our banner back to our group. In order to participate in this activity groups need to either create or buy their own Narcotics Anonymous related banner. This is so our group and other groups can capture another group's banner. If your group participates in this activity and your group's banner has been captured, your group must take five home group members to the group that has captured your banner to get it back. If you would like to capture the banner (in addition to recapturing your own banner) of the group you area attending, you must take an additional five home group members to capture their banner. It takes five home group members to get one banner. In other words, you must have ten home group members to recapture your banner and the other group's banner. Just like our recovery is free for the taking, so is our banner! You just have to show up! We hope that there is at least one group that will accept our invitation and "Capture our Banner"!
