I attended the RSC held in April 2007 in Salem, OR. Here is a summary of the business conducted at the meeting.

Chairperson

The results of the Regional nomination process left some positions void of nomination. In order for the Region to conduct business the Executive Committee of the PCRNA must be elected at the next Regional business meeting in July in Coos Bay, OR.

Vice-Chairperson

The Vice Chairperson reported on the issue of the use of Credit Cards by the PNW#29 committee. The information received is that a credit card machine from a third party company was used to process credit card charges. The financial statements have been accounted for. The paper receipts have not been located. The attempt to match the financial statements to the credit card receipts is not a possibility. The Treasurer of the PNW#29 was not available and was not able to identify the location of the paper receipts. The Vice Chairperson's recommendation is that hereafter no third party credit card machines be used for PNW conventions and that the PNW conventions obtain a credit card machine for its' exclusive use.

Secretary

The Secretary reported that the minutes were on the web site within three weeks of the last RSC

Treasurer

The Treasure reported:

The Treasurer reported that the financial accounting process for the Region has been transfer to the Quick Books software system and is working well. The Treasurer purchased a printer from the Treasures' budgeted allocations for \$69.

Regional Delegate

The Regional Delegate presented each Area with a new Public Relations Handbook. The purpose of the Public Relations Handbook is to provide a dynamic manual and model of how the Narcotics Anonymous service structure is organized and how it works. The Handbook is a resource that is in addition to the Guide to Local Services. The Handbook contains information about area planning, how to carry the message, inventory process and goal setting.
