Subject: **February 2008 Report**

Good Morning Area, my name is Gerry and I am an addict.

- Pacific Cascade Regional Assembly on January 19th and 20th, 2008 in Salem, Oregon

I attended the Regional Assembly in January in Salem. My report is about the motions that are to be acted upon at the World Service Conference (WSC.) All of the motions put to the WSC are available for proposed amendment, except Motion 1, and if Motion 1 passes, Motion 2.

Motion 1. This motion is the revision to the Basic Text personal stories. This motion will be voted on to approve it as submitted or reject it. No revisions to this motion will be accepted.

Motion 2. This is the companion to Motion 1. This motion adds various edits and new text to the Basic Text. If Motion 1 fails, Motion 2 will not be submitted.

Motion 3. This motion allows the World Board (WB) to amend the number of meetings cited in the text of the Basic Text as new information becomes available and as new printings of the Basic Text is prepared.

Motion 4. The motion allows the WB to edit the Just For Today book to note quotations taken from Narcotics Anonymous literature that are no longer in print.

Motion 5. This motion allows the WB to add a new and revised Index to the new Basic Text. The discussion at the Regional Assembly revealed that the new and revised Index is not in the Conference Agenda Report (CAR). It may be available to the WSC attendees and may be available at [www.na.org](http://www.na.org) before the WSC. Some members felt that the new Index should be part of a future CAR and that this motion should be amended to reflect that desire. The WB wants to continue with the development of the new Basic Text, including the revised Index, which has been created, but was not available to be part of the WSC 2008 CAR.

Motion 6. This motion is two edits to the Basic Text. The discussion in the CAR about this motion included information about pricing, size of the new Basic Text, availability and sales of the Basic Text, Fifth Edition.

Motion 7. This motion is to replace an existing IP, *Youth and Recovery*, with a new IP, *By Young Addicts, For Young Addicts*.

Motion 8. This motion creates a new IP, *For the Parents or Guardians of Young People in Narcotics Anonymous*. This new IP is part of the effort of the WB to create IPs that target specific populations that would benefit from IPs addressing their particular needs or circumstances.

Motion 9. This motion directs the WB to produce English only Roman numeral medallions as a specialty item. The \$13,000 cost is for the dies for the English only medallions. At the Regional Assembly, the discussion revealed that the change from producing Roman numeral medallions to Arabic numeral medallions was a decision made by the WB and was not from a motion put to a WSC.

Motion 10. This motion directs the WB to produce Roman numeral medallions in all finishes and languages produced by Narcotics Anonymous World Services (NAWS). The choice to continue the production of Arabic numeral medallions is left to the WB. The region proposing this motion believes that this is the will of the local Areas and groups. The WB opposes Motions 9 and 10 because the production of both Roman numeral and Arabic numeral medallions would unsatisfactorily increase the inventory management responsibility of NAWS.

Motion 11. Motion 11 directs the WB to give \$36,000 to the Northern New Jersey Region to pay for part of the costs of a lawsuit filed against Narcotics Anonymous. The Northern New Jersey Region has defended itself in court causing a \$91,000 expenditure. This issue was thoroughly discussed at the Regional Assembly. It appears that one individual has filed a lawsuit against five individuals, an Area, a recovery house, the WSO and NAWS. The Northern New Jersey Region prevailed in court and is now asking for money from the WB to pay for the cost. It is not known if there are additional appeals pending about this issue. The WB opposes this motion because the WB does not want to set a precedent that gives the appearance that the WB directs, controls or is responsible for the actions of Narcotics Anonymous regions, areas, groups or individual members of the fellowship. Some ideas suggested at the Regional Assembly included individual members of the fellowship, who are willing to identify themselves as such, making donations to the Northern New Jersey Region.

Motion 12. This motion requires that all that all Narcotics Anonymous Service pamphlets intended for group and individual use be included in the Conference Agenda Report for approval. The controversy arises from some service pamphlets produced by the WB that did not meet the expectations of some members of the fellowship, specifically around the issue of abstinence and the use of medically prescribed medications. The discussion at the Regional Assembly concerned the perceived need of the fellowship to see and approve all Narcotics Anonymous literature before it becomes 'Conference approved' or 'Board approved.' The WB opposes this motion because the WB was to given the direction at WSC 2006 to 'allow the world board to develop and approve service-related information pamphlets and tools for distribution to the fellowship.'
