I attended the business meeting of the Pacific Cascade Region of Narcotics Anonymous held on February 9, 2008 in Eugene, OR. Here is a summary of the meeting minutes of the RSC:

Pacific Cascade Regional Service Committee

Meeting Minutes

- Motion to approve minutes as amended
 - Approved

Open positions:

- The open positions were read and nominations asked for. There were no nominations

Regional Executive Committee Reports

Chairperson

- All Major motions and subcommittee guidelines need to be reviewed prior to submission to the PCRSC.
- The Activities subcommittee has completed the guidelines review.

Vice-Chairperson

- There will be some revisions to PNW proposed by laws amendment:
 - Include all convention chairpersons and
 - Replacement of chairpersons as needed by convention committee pending election at the next available RSC
- The PCRSC by laws are in need of review and revision.
- Contact was made with the State of Oregon Department of Revenue about state gambling regulations. There will be an additional report.
- The PCRSC Treasurer is in need of professional assistance in order to carry out the tasks of preparing the reports required by the RSC.

Secretary

- All meeting minutes emailed per the list of email addresses

Treasurer

- The Bank account is balanced, bills have been paid and the accruals are full
- The Budget is in the process of being prepared. The problems encountered by the Treasurer is that the current Quick Books system is set up for a cash basis accounting, whereas the Regional financial operation is performed using an accrual basis of accounting. The Treasurer will work within the major motions passed at this RSC to obtain the necessary information about how to transfer the cash basis to an accrual basis accounting method. A budget document was presented to the RSC at this meeting but it was determined that additional work needs to be done before this document can be presented to the local Areas for voting. Additional progress reporting concerning the budget will be made at the next RSC. The PCRSC will be able to work with the current budget until a new budget is approved.

Regional Delegate

- The RD conducted the Regional Assembly in Salem OR. Discussion items were:
 - CAR and Basic Text discussion
 - Discussion on decision questions
- Action items are:
 - Information collected from the Regional Assembly will be included in the RSC minutes
- The CAR will be published on line at www.na.org
- Dates of the World Service Conference: April-May 2008
- The local area group voting concerning the motion in the CAR will be collected at the next RSC.

Alternate Delegate

- The AD traveled to Assembly in Salem and Area Inventory at EASC
- The AD is interested in collecting information about how many H&I panels take place per week; how much \$ is spent on literature for H&I; presence of phone lines at areas; any other issues that should be taken to the World Service Conference

Pacific Cascade Regional Convention

- A report was received from the convention representative. The convention will take place in Bend OR.
- The convention committee:
 - Is soliciting workshop speakers
 - Requesting re-registration
 - Has raised \$3,500 from fund raising, \$6,000 from merchandise sales; paid out about \$7,000 and has about a \$5,000 cash balance.
 - Will present a written budget at the next RSC

PNW Ad Hoc Committee

- The EASC (now Lane County Area of Narcotics Anonymous) has submitted a revised motion.
- What changed?
 - Expanded to add all convention chairpersons; PNW and Pacific Cascade Regional conventions and any other conventions sponsored by the PCRSC
 - In the event that the chairperson position becomes vacant the subcommittee may appoint an interim Chairperson that will be elected by the PCRSC
- This proposed amendment is referred to the local groups

Conference and Conventions

- The next RSC will be on April 19, 2008 RSC in Canby OR,
- The committee has submitted guidelines for conventions
- A Regional Assemble and RSC will take place in July 19, 20 2008
 - At the Assembly the Regional Delegate will present the results of the motions voted on at the World Service Conference

Literature

- The committee met today with two areas in attendance.
- A literature project for the first year of recovery has begun.
- The chairperson is requesting that area literature chairpersons attend the literature committee meeting

Policies and Procedures

- The chairperson announced and passed out Revisions to the hand book.

Public Information

- The committee met with seven areas attending
- Area telephone cards were made available
- A Learning Days has been scheduled for the July 2008 Regional Assembly
- The committee is seeking a new web host for Regional web site beginning in July 2008

Area Reports

- The local area reports were presented. The text of the reports is available on the Regional web site.

Open Forum

- World Delegate and Alternate Delegate terms of office
 - The current practice of one year terms does not allow for sufficient time for the WD or alternate to become experienced enough to represent the interests of the Region at the World Conference.
 - A possible solution is to elect the WD and AD to two year terms with and allow the incumbent to run for one more two year term.
 - Because the World Conventions are biannual, the AD would attend the world convention twice before becoming the WD and therefore would have more experience with the position.
- Issue of suffixes for area web site
 - All Narcotics Anonymous web sites represent Narcotics Anonymous to the public
 - A .com is a commercial suffix whereas a .org is used by a non-profit designation
 - The question is should the guidelines specify which type of suffix is used by the local areas.
- Helping struggling geographic areas
 - Some remotely located local groups may be isolated due to geography or other issues.
 - Outreach committees may be helpful to connect these groups with local areas
- Comingle the H&I and PI efforts with other social or recovery based organizations

- In some areas the area sponsored H&I and PI committees are working with local social or recovery based organizations.
- Is this activity a tradition violation?

Good of the Order

- The Gambling Issue
 - What is gambling in the state of Oregon?
 - What can the RSC do or not do in respect to gaming?
 - There is a conflict about what is planned for conventions in the near future and what the Oregon laws state about gaming
 - The PCRSC could become a state registered private non-profit organization and apply for tax exempt status with the IRS.
 - Doing so would allow the PCRSC to conduct licensed gaming activities within the law.

Hello Area, my name is Dee and I am an addict. I would like to thank Dennis for representing PI last month in my absence.

There is a lot going on in the PI world getting ready for the Area name change and positions changing coming up next month, as of right now all positions except the chairperson will be open in April, which are the Vice chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Phone line Coordinator, Booth Coordinator, Web servant and Committee Contact person.

We have completed our quarterly mailings. We had 75 phone calls this month; 4 from 411, so the phone is being answered although I did receive several phone calls and was told in person about concerns of a phone carrier and asked the coordinator to get back the phone. Just as a reminder, the Phone line Coordinator position will be open and we can always use more phone carriers.

The Web site: I have been working very close with the Web servant to get the Area name change all set up for the new chairperson before I leave this position, as of right now we have 2 domain names, we still have the old one for one year that the web servant paid for @ \$34.99 for 1 year, we will be reimbursing him with the PI allotment, the 2nd one is for the new name and it is \$10.00 for one year and the web servant asked for this to be his donation to NA. The new website address is lanecountyarea-na.org. People can get to this web site with the old email address and there is a message on the home page letting them know about the change. I brought the page with me today. The web servant also put the new name into search engines and the link at the World web site. So Hugh kudos for our web servant.

I do have concerns around the funding for the phone, the phone number in the phone book and the web site due to dipping into the operating reserve a lot, but I have learned that if these things are meant to be here to carry our message all will be well, I just worry.

May I please get our allotment?

Region: I attended Region and here is what is happening in the PI world there. There will be WSLD in 2009 possibly in Portland, Oregon. Phone cards are smaller but can get more on them. Motion/proposal for the Region PI meeting becomes consensus decisions. Past WSLD's are on the Region's Web site. New Web site's are Mid Willamette Valley @ www.mwvana.com and Tualatin Valley @ tvana.org. The Umaqua Valley, Rouge Red Wood and Coos bay Area's all have a Public Relations Committee that include H&I and PI and these are smaller Area's. Rose City Metro also has a Public Relations Committee that includes the Hotline, Outreach and PI. I was asked if our area had one and I said no, PI has chosen not to do this.

Since there is little time at Region to conduct business we are asked to send our Area reports to the chair person ahead of time and have discussion through instant messaging between Regions.

My name is Kevin and I am an addict, last month was disappointing because it appeared that the disease of addiction was winning in our area. I say this out of personal experience, when I was using I would make plans to fix my problems and then expect others to do the work. I would commit to a course of action that required others to make time for me, only to leave early or not show up at all. I would make rules for others that didn't apply to me, and then blame others for my failings. I justified my dereliction by pointing out your

inferiority, and then admonished you for daring to question my character. I did all these things in my active addiction (using or not) and it caused me great guilt and shame whenever I quit denying my part. The only relief I found is in the program of Narcotics Anonymous and the love of a fellowship that told me to keep coming back no matter how I acted or how much I hurt. It is with this newly found relief that I can come here today ready to be of service no matter how we act or how much we hurt.

Today we will complete steps 5 (Creating approaches) & 6 (Prioritizing approaches) in the Area Planning process, and then the body will need to decide how to proceed with step 7 (Developing an action plan). I look forward to this process.
