PCRSC Proposed Budget for 2008-2009

My name is Dee and I an addict. The first thing I want to say something about the reports being read, I don't feel like they are being heard when they are giving. In February I stated that the old web domain is paid for, for one year and PI would reimburse the web servant the \$34.99 and the new domain is paid for, for one year at \$10.00 as a donation from the web servant. There was a lack of communication or something because in March the old domain was paid for, for 9 years. We had to cancel that domain and get reimbursed the 9 year amount plus the one year amount that the web servant purchased. If we wanted to purchase it again it would cost \$125.00 plus the cost for one year of \$34.99. So we no longer have the old web site and it does not exist anymore. Just to make it clear the Eugene-or-na.org address does not exist anymore, only the lanecountyarea-na.org exists.
