### **REGIONAL COMMITTEE MEMBER (RCM) –**

Dear Family,

It was my pleasure to attend the Region Service Meeting for the Pacific Cascades Region this past month. I have returned \$5 of my allotment and a receipt for \$45 in gas to the treasurer. I arrived early and had the opportunity to attend the Activities Subcommittee meeting. They are looking forward to our Interim Chair attending in July. Following is a synopsis of the information I received at Region.

Unfortunately our Vice Chair resigned his position.

The Secretary has asked that all Region Subcommittee Chairs submit their reports in writing or by email. There

were no subcommittee reports in last quarter's minutes because none were submitted to him.

The treasurer reported that all seed money has been paid that was requested and the allotments are filled for the quarter.

Please find the correct spellings in my report which will be in the minutes, or see me after the meeting. The Delegates are reporting live to the Region Secretary and Website each day of the Conference, which has been this past week. I will be including the web links for that information.

The Conferences and Conventions Chair reported about the upcoming RSCs, dates and locations. Don't forget the PCRCNA 15 is this coming weekend in Bend. They will also be submitting the Conferences and Conventions Guidelines for our review and approval.

I will leave it in the capable hands of our elected Subcommittee Chairs to give reports on what happened in their respective committees; Hospitals and Institutions, Literature and Public Information.

I was glad to have the opportunity to represent our Area at the Activities subcommittee. They held elections and the following persons were elected: Chair –Steve R and Vice Chair –Richard R. The other officers will be recorded in the Region Minutes. Conferences and Conventions returned 33 T-Shirts to activities from the January 2008 RSC. I have the Lane County Area's allotment of those T-shirts and will be handing them over to our Area Activities subcommittee.

It appeared that most of the Subcommittees have or will be submitting updated guidelines for approval at the next RSC in July.

I will note highlights from the other Area reports. Full reports will be available in the Region Minutes. These minutes are available online through a link on our Region website. The highlights from other areas are as follows:

Central Oregon – held some service workshops that were mildly successful, but they are struggling with unity in their area and several officer positions are open. The Secretary position has been open for 2 months. They have also used the Area Planning tool and are hoping to start using the “Strengthen Home Groups” materials.

Portland Area –They are also in the process of using the Area Planning Tool for an inventory. In addition they donated \$5,000.00 to Region this quarter. WOW –how great.

Tualitan Area –Their subcommittees are active, attended and doing well. They have a newly activated Hospitals and Institutions committee.

### On to *Unfinished Business*:

Open positions for our Regions are Alternate Secretary, Archivist and Alternate Treasurer. The Interim Vice Chair Position that opened at the beginning of business was filled by Mike R, previously of the Eugene Area, currently of the Portland Area. Two nominations were submitted for this interim position. Gerry M, from Lane County Area was the second person.

The Public Information Guidelines that were submitted at last RSC were voted on and passed.

The Motion to add the position of Convention Chairperson to the guidelines was voted on and passed.

The Region Budget – Did not Pass. There was some discussion and confusion by a couple of the Areas. I believe that more information and explanation was given to those RCMs and we will vote again in July. If the new budget does not pass, our guidelines state that the current budget will continue to be in effect.

### *New Business*:

The Treasurer reported that after having paid out the bills and filling the allotments we had available funds of \$3,701.91.

The following motions are shortened notes. I will have the exact wording available for this area at the next ASC in June after I have received my copy of the Region Minutes.

Motion #1 –Public Information requested \$400 in funds to purchase pens, magnets, and notepads with the Region website and Area phonenumber numbers printed on them for handing out at the Region Learning Days in July. I regret to say, my memory does not serve me well in this vote. I believe after much discussion and questions that this motion was passed. I will confirm next month.

Motion #2 –Region Delegate requested \$50.94 reimbursement for cost of copies. Passed

Motion #3 -Conferences and Conventions requested \$47.81 be given to the Mid Willamette Valley Area to return funds. They took a loss from hosting the January Assembly. Passed.

Motion #4 –Tabled and referred to Areas.

Monies in the amount of \$2150.00 held in our budget to cover seed money that will be needed for upcoming events. This seed money will be getting requested over the course of the next 6 months to 1 year for the following: \$350.00 for the PCRSC, \$1200.00 for the PCRCNA and \$600.00 for the PCRSCA.

Motion #5 –Webhost requested that we revise the Website committee guidelines to reflect a more reasonable clean time requirement. From 4 years for Chair and 2 years for Vice-Chair to 2 years for Chair and 1 year for Vice Chair. Passed

Nominations were opened and accepted. Elections will be held during the July RSC.

Due to the request for funds from the Mid Willamette Valley Area to cover their loss, some mention was made that provisions could be put in place to prevent this in the future by allowing them to keep merchandise for sale to cover the loss. I believe that Activities was going to discuss this with their new guidelines.
