**Public Information sub-committee, Lane County Area**

Good morning area, my name is Dennis and I'm an addict.

It's booth season and we have gone out to the public twice this year so far but the season didn't start out well. When Dee I went to check on PI booth two weeks before our 1<sup>st</sup> outing the canopy for the booth was missing from the activities locker and no one knew where to find it, come to find out the men's retreat took it to the coast 2 months earlier and never returned it. We have the canopy back now but the committee feels it's not safe to store anything in the locker. The system is broken. We will be storing the booth at our booth coordinators home until the end of the season and we will make a decision what to do next at that time.

PI needs a phonline coordinator with 18 month clean time. If we don't get a volunteer to help with scheduling the phone carriers, changes will need to be made in our phonline services for the Lane County Area. Concept #2 States "The final responsibility and authority for NA services rests with the NA groups. More will be revealed.

At the request of some of the groups last month I have brought WSO meeting list updates and new group registration forms. Make any changes on the form today and PI will send them to the WSO office.
