P.R./HELPLINE - LCASC Public Relations Sub-committee Chair Report - June 2009

Greetings! This month will be our 1st PR Booth at Saturday Market on 6/20. We are still in need of people to sit in the booth this summer. Please take a look at the sign-up sheet going around and sign-up for any dates that may work for you. We will be doing a total of 3 Saturday Markets (each on the 3rd Sat. of the month) and the Eugene Celebration the 1st weekend of September, but none of these will occur without some help from you...please sign up if you can.

We started with a balance of \$113.30, we paid rent for our meeting space, \$5.00 and I was reimbursed a partial payment of \$20.00 to go toward the \$45.00 purchasing of the Help Book Human Resource Guide for Lane County. This book is necessary to keep our mailings current and to explore other ways we may be able to reach out to our community. Our remaining balance is \$88.30. We will be accepting our allotment this month in order to cover the cost of our participation in the Eugene Celebration and to go toward updating our rubber stamp with the "Public Relations" change, as well as, literature and business cards for our next mailing.

We have started to work on getting Narcotics Anonymous PSA's out into the community....more on that to come

I've been in contact with our web servant regarding the addition of a mailing list link specifically for Community Based Organizations that would like to be on the PR mailing list. The link will go to a basic info screen for them to input their contact info (name, address, e-mail, phone or fax) and an area for comments/requests...this info would then be forwarded to our committee for use with our quarterly mailings. And now....more of the facts related to the virtual PBX phone system I mentioned last month. Our current costs are \$11.45/month for the helpline MTM voice mailbox, \$80/month for the Verizon cell phone, and about \$20/month to have the Quest router number, for a total cost of \$111.45/month. We don't have an annual contract with MTM...that could be stopped at any time. Our Verizon contract ends 11/14/09, which would allow us time to change everything over to a new system. With Quest, we have no annual contract, but we maintain the number in order to be listed in the Dex phonebook. I believe the number would have to stay active until the new phone book submissions are taken by Dex next year....starting in Jan. 2010 and ending in May 2010.

Freedom Operator virtual PBX phone system would have a start up cost of \$134.90. This cost includes:

- a down payment of the month cost of \$29.95 (first and last month)
- one-time start-up fee of \$25.00
- one-time fee to keep current helpline #, \$30.00
- one-time fee of \$10.00 to list in the phone book (the \$3.00/month)
- unlimited minutes, unless out of area \$10.00/month

Total Start-up cost \$134.90

Cost per month:

- \$29.95 monthly rate
- \$10.00 unlimited minute (unless volunteer has out of area phone #, then it would be a toll charge. We can avoid this issue through guidelines for phone line volunteer s)
- \$3.00 monthly phonebook listing cost

Total monthly cost: \$42.95

The total annual cost of our current system is \$1343.40, annual cost of Freedom Operator is \$515.40....that's an annual savings to our area of \$828.

And finally....in July of 2008, a former PI member took the Regional booth back, but never picked up the \$37.50 in travel money given to PI at that time. The former member has since relapsed and is unavailable. What would you like our committee to do with the money?
