This last month James and I went to Region in Rouge Redwood area. There were 20 areas in all there. James and I started off our morning going to C&C the discussion of October RSC 2010 Was up to us and Coos Bay Area, while talking about the RSC the subject of the CAR came up and I was asked if we would do it and hold on the RSC. Portland has wanted to do the CAR and was again not present. After much discussion we have been asked to hold on RSC and be ready to do the CAR in February.

Portland is working to resolve the issue at hand.

I would like to thank each of our subcommittee chairs for showing up to the sub committee meetings in the morning. We had each committee there and that says a lot for our area. Working together to carry the message is what we are doing.

So with our area giving the closing report Rouge redwood stepped up to host the PCRCNA#17 in 2011, we voted in the new chair it is Dominic from the Rouge Red Wood Area. There is a budget in the works and two locations they are working with at this time. The committee is filling in the blanks with in the committee and will have a full committee this next quarterly meeting.

PNWCNA #33 handed in their Budget and had asked for it to be voted on and was voted in, my concern came with the entrapment was very high and asked for it to be tabled till our next meeting. Motion to table was voted down. The Budget is very well presented the one item that seems lavas is Rocky recovery the cost is \$12'500.00. It seems to me this may be going far to reach a level that could allow the convention to not pay for its self. The over all budget is \$139,839.00. They have already raised \$31,036.11 with fundraising. I felt this should have gone back to the areas for review, its hard for me to say that this is ok without it coming back to the groups. They did hand out the pre registration forms to all areas. The PNW committee is moving along very well and seems to have a great committee on hand. Please don't get me wrong they are doing a very good job, it's just this budget that raised a red flag for me and I though this body needed to know this.

The Areas are all doing well, there were some areas that traveled many miles to come and share how things have been. North coast, Siskiyou Area where present. This showed me we are working to be a whole and work to carry the message. Portland is still working on the metro but looks like all talks have stopped for now.

The sub committee chairs have all changed hands this last meeting and some was there first time reporting to the body. H&I Holly was the one committee that didn't change hands. It looks as if they are doing very well. PI has come together very well over this last two years and have one of the strongest committees. They have started meeting the day before as a group and setting out new projects to care the message and show the suffering addict they are not alone.

In my report I did let the body know about our PR project with the new phone line, the feedback was great and many areas asked about the workings and what we are doing to implement this in to be a working phone line. I did give them the info I had and as well as Gina's phone #.

This meeting we started reviewing the Inventory all the areas handed in this will be covered by our ALT RCM James M.

P.R./HELPLINE - Greetings!

I'm thrilled to report that we have finally gotten our mailing letters and comment cards printed and hope to have them in the mail by month's end.

Dennis A. represented our committee at our Regional Service meeting last month; I'll let him briefly update you on that topic since I was not there.

Just to keep everyone up to date on the new Helpline...There has been a brief delay in getting the new helpline set up related to getting the funding placed in the appropriate location to set up the account. Also, our original exploration of the new Helpline began at the end of April; by the end of May I had negotiated a package price with Freedom Operator. It has been so long since my original negotiation that the company has since changed their name to Freedom Voice and altered the package price. However, yesterday morning I spoke to the representative that has been working with me since May regarding the new Helpline. He will let me know next week if they can still offer us the same package at the same price; there may be a \$10 increase in the monthly base rate if he cannot offer the same package price. This would still allow a savings of \$700 annually.

We also have a new Helpline Coordinator; Nick P. will be taking over this position once we get up and running. Shag will continue to manage the current Helpline and help with the transition to the new Helpline....I'm also very hopeful that he'll remain a volunteer!

Our work on the Narcotics Anonymous PSA's continues....we will decide on scripts for the PSA's at this month's PR meeting and hope to have more specific production information by next month's ASC.

As I continue to mention, we hope to focus more on developing a Newcomer Workshop once the Helpline is settled a bit.
