LCASC Handbook Revision and Production Report—12/05/09

Hello Everyone, On February 2nd, 2008 the Eugene ASC voted to change the ASC name to the Lane County ASC. At that time, in a moment, I saw in my mind all that would have to be done to change the handbook. I was mostly accurate except it took about 14 months longer to accomplish the task than I expected. We started by looking at the Area minutes archive and found that there were 21 missing months of minutes. Over a 6 month period we found all but June and July of 2000. We then reviewed the old Handbook and made many copy edit changes and changed the name of area. We then reviewed all the minutes from 2000 to August 2009 to look for changes that had not been incorporated into the handbook and included them. We reviewed bylaws revision committee work from 2003 and 2007 that somehow never quite made it into the handbook. Then we transferred all the various files into one Word file and changed it all to the Novarese Book font. This font was selected because in a 56 page document you can save about 6-7 pages per handbook (which is about \$50-80). If the font seems familiar it might be because it is used in the book "It Works, How and Why." We used the November 2009 minutes to type the Group, Officer and Subcommittee Names on the covers. If the name or title does not appear as you would like it to appear you may contact Greg Ivy by phone or by email and a new cover can be made for your handbook. We are asking everyone who takes a handbook to register they received the handbook so we can help groups and Executive committee members locate the handbooks and to help with any updates that need to be made to the handbooks. If while reading the handbooks you find mistakes in spelling,

grammar or otherwise, please write it down and give it or email it to the ASC Secretary so corrections can be made with future revisions. Making changes every 1-2 years would likely be much easier than every 12 years.

P.R./HELPLINE LCASC Public Relations Sub-committee Chair Report –December 2009

Greetings!

I'm pleased to announce that PR has finally been able to get the mock up version of the new Helpline!!! The mock system allows for a free 15 day trial with Freedom Voice, using a toll free number; this number can be used for training purposes as long as we feel is necessary. We will be able to port the current Helpline number once we are ready. Not only will the new system allow for the calls to be forwarded to a volunteer's phone, it will eventually have recorded meeting information by the day, allow for literature orders to be placed, have a listing

of current events, and the ability to leave messages or forward calls to the chairpersons of our sub-committees. As I've mentioned before, this is a huge undertaking for our area. We really need your support, so sign up to do a Helpline shift and help an addict reach NA.

The breakdowns of the Helpline costs are as follows:

- \$30.00 one-time fee to port our current Helpline number
- \$10.00 per month to maintain our local number
- \$39.95 per month for the service itself
- \$5.00 per month custom phone tree option

This makes the initial start-up fee \$84.95. Our monthly fee thereafter will be \$54.95 or \$659.40 annually. We will have to continue to pay \$20 per month or \$240 annually to Quest to maintain our router number in the phone book. Our total annual cost for the new Helpline will be \$899.40. Given that our current system costs us approximately \$1343.40 annually, we will be saving a total annual cost of \$444.00 per year.

We are continuing to work on getting the PSA project off the ground and hope to start development of a Newcomer Workshop early next year.
